THE CHAMPIONSHIPS RULES:

- Game duration
 - **Open Boys 2 x 25minute halves**
 - **5 minutes half time**
 - **5 minutes between games**
- The Referee shall start the game at the time as per the Draw. If one team is not prepared for the schedule start of play, a goal shall be conceded by the Association for every 3 minutes of delay. If 15 minutes of delay occur, the offending Association shall forfeit the game and a 5–nil loss recorded.
- **If the difference in score between two teams reaches 7 goals then the game will be declared completed, irrespective of time remaining in the game.** For recording purposes, the game shall be declared a victory to the winning team with the appropriate competition points and for and against goals awarded to both teams at the time the game is stopped. The time remaining in the game shall be played, but the two teams can be mixed in consultation with selectors and in agreement with the teams' management.

THE LEAGUE FORMAT COMPETITION:

1. Each Association shall play against each other Association in a League format
2. Each Association must supply 2 game quality balls for all matches
3. The result of each Match shall be submitted by the winning Manager to the Convenor. In the event of a draw the result is to be submitted by the number appearing first on the Draw for the specific game.
4. Points awarded for matches
Win = Three (3) points Draw = One (1) point Loss = Zero (0) points
5. The position of each Association in the table shall be determined by the number of points obtained throughout the Championships in numerical order with the highest at the top.
6. If any 2 or more Association have obtained the same number of points their position in the table shall be determined on goal difference, that is to say, the difference between the total number of goals scored and conceded at the Championship. Association with the greatest goal difference will be placed higher.
7. If any 2 or more Associations have obtained the same number of points and have the same goal difference the higher placed Association will be determined by who has scored the most goals at the Championship.
8. If any 2 or more Associations have obtained the same number of points, have the same goal difference and have scored the same number of goals they shall be deemed to be equal on the table.
